

Maritime transport is recognized as an effective solution to increase the sustainability of the transport system. The role of the ports becomes vital, especially in the Mediterranean area with a majority of urban ports, for two main reasons: as a gateway of the intermodality transport network to access the surrounding inner regions; as strategic area to solve the urban port-city interface, both reducing the environmental impact of road/sea traffic accessing the port and including the port area into the social life of the urban community.

The PORTA project, within the framework of the EU Integrated Maritime Policy in the Mediterranean space, aims to overcome the dichotomy between maritime and transport policies and urban/local sustainable development of the areas surrounding the ports, by adopting new planning integrated approaches in the fields of transport, land use, urban environment and local governance.

This project, funded by the MED Program, has been carried out in three years (1.6.2010 – 30.5.2013) joining partners from five Mediterranean countries (Spain, Italy, France, Greece and Slovenia) to develop a new system of guidelines for integrating regional planning and port management.

The PORTA Final Conference “Port, city, territory. Integrated development strategies” is structured in two-days activities, including a Seminar on the project and the International Port-city networking, and a Workshop with a focus on Catania port area.
